## **Food Bank**

On behalf of HABSR, Bishop would like to thank everyone, all who gave at the women's day celebrations, and all parishes concerned for the generous donations towards the food bank. The warm heartedness of everyone will ensure this foodbank will never be empty.

Our foodbank is now up and running, and we had a suggestion to break the foodbank up into archdeaconries so food is more accessible from the various archdeaconry areas which are far from the diocese.

The other request is for no profiles to be made up of recipients on the first distribution of food parcels, only if there is a second request.

At the most recent HABSR Board meeting it was agreed that the distribution of the food parcels should stay in one central point and applications for food parcels to be directed to the HABSR office from the parishes. Profiles of the recipients will be made from the start.

Attached is an application form for this purpose, to be filled out by the parish, or project concerned and sent to HABSR. The office will make up the food parcel ready for collection. The purpose of this foodbank is to assist recipients on a short term basis and to assess their current social circumstances for the purposes of aid. The recipient may need further assistance with clothes, school fee waiving, social grant applications, counselling etc. to help them back on their feet.

The screening of the recipients of the food parcel will need to be done by the parish concerned. The reason for this screening process is:

- a) for further aid if necessary,
- b) and to be accountable and transparent.

Attached is a list of the food that will be in the food parcels. This list may change from time to time according to the stock available.
